ANNOUNCEMENT

The European Acoustics Association (EAA) will, according to its objectives, promote the active participation of young researchers and students at the **Forum Acusticum 2011, to be held in Aalborg, Denmark from June 26 to July 1, 2011** with grants and awards.

A. GRANTS FOR YOUNG RESEARCHERS

EAA will support with grants the participation of **10** young researchers and students from East European Countries in the Congress. The grant includes **free registration**.

To apply for these grants, young researchers must be:

- a) enrolled to a university course (Bachelor, Master, PhD) or already have a Master or a PhD degree
- b) no more than 30 years old on 01.01.2011
- c) citizen of one of the following European countries, member of EAA: Belarus, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Montenegro, Poland, Romania, Russia, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Ukraine
- d) first author of the paper that will be presented at Forum Acusticum 2011

Interested young researchers **must submit** their abstracts to the congress website <http://www.fa2011.org/>. Please note that they have to tick the box "EAA grant applicant", when submitting their abstract.

In parallel, they have to **send** their application in electronic form to the General Secretary of EAA secretary@european-acoustics.net

before 31 January, 2011

The application must include the following documents (in pdf format):

- a) university enrolment certificate (for Master or PhD students)
- b) copy of the university degree (for other young researchers)
- c) birth and citizenship certificate or a passport copy
- d) short curriculum vitae with list of publications
- e) letter of support from the supervisor
- f) abstract of the paper submitted to Forum Acusticum 2011 + one page of theory/experiments/results/conclusion.

The Board of the European Acoustics Association, on the basis of the applications received, will publish a list of winners of the grants **before 28 February, 2011** on the EAA web site www.eaa-fenestra.org and will inform the winners accordingly.

The winners are invited to present the contribution in oral or poster form at the Congress.

B. EAA BEST PAPER AND PRESENTATION AWARDS FOR YOUNG RESEARCHERS

The EAA will offer six Best Paper and Presentation Awards to young researchers who will present a paper as first author at Forum Acusticum 2011 Conference.

AWARD AMOUNT:

500 €

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible to the “Best Paper and Presentation Award” the young researcher must:

- a) be no more than 35 years old on 01.01.2011.
- b) be the first author of the submitted abstract and full paper
- c) present the paper at the meeting (oral or poster presentation)

SELECTION:

The award winners will be selected by a jury nominated by the Board of the European Acoustics Association. The selection will be based upon the quality of both the content of the paper and its presentation. The awards will be announced either at the conference or after the closing of the conference.

APPLICATION:

All those who wish to participate in the competition for the EAA Best Paper and Presentation Awards must indicate their intention by sending an e-mail, to the General Secretary of EAA secretary@european-acoustics.net with the subject line: *For EAA Best Paper Award*

before 31 May, 2011
